<b>SUBJECT</b> OPERATIONS CHIEF REPORT FOR 090320				
<p>On 090320 I was assigned as the Operations Chief for events in Portland.</p> <p>At 2122 a group that had gathered at Laurelherst Park started marching towards SE precinct. The group was bout 150-200 people and they arrived at SE at 2135.</p> <p>Upon arrival the sound truck gave announcements that people needed to stay off of Precinct property.</p> <p>At 2140 projectiles were being thrown into the parking lot from the 47th Ave side. The light volley of water bottles and the occasional rock continued for about an hour. At 2249 a person threw a stick that hit one of the patrol cars. At 2320 a couple of rocks were thrown at, and hit some patrol cars. At 2325 the sound truck gave announcements about not throwing items at the officers. These included warnings for force and arrest. At 2339 another rock was thrown at officers.</p> <p>At 2358 a custody movement occurred and a person who had been throwing rocks was taken into custody. Units disengaged after the custody, and several bottles were thrown at them as they moved back into the lot. More bottle were still being thrown at 0002.</p> <p>At 0018 a vehicle sped through the crowd going east. The vehicle was topped away from the crowd, and the driver was cited.</p> <p>At 0022 the sound truck gave announcements the street was open and the crowd needed to move out of the street.</p> <p>At 0052 ground units walked to 47/Burnside to advise some vehicles parked in the lanes of travel to leave the area or they would be subject to citation and tow. Ground unit disengaged again at 0056.</p> <p>At 0112 MFF's move in with their vehicles and stopped some of the vehicles that again were blocking the street. An arrest was made and citation issued. One vehicle was also towed.</p> <p>At 0135 a mattress was found on fire in the street at 50/Burnside. Other barricades that had been put in the street were moved out of the way by officers.</p> <p>At 0153 ground units disengaged from the crowd.</p>

<p>On 9/3/20, I was tasked as the Mobile Field Force Sergeant for North C shift. On this day, protesters marched on SE Precinct. My squad was tasked with covering the East side of the precinct. While on post, I saw several people wearing "PRESS" labels on their outer clothing handing unknown items to two different persons holding shields. Later in the night, persons holding similar shields were seen throwing items at the police. This occurred on the south side of the street across from east driveway for the precinct on Burnside.</p> <p>No member of North C Mobile Field Force used force or made any arrests this night. The officers on the North C MFF were:</p> <p>Officers [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Edner, Shadron, Elias, Whitmore, Romanowski, Johnson, Polas and Winter.</p>

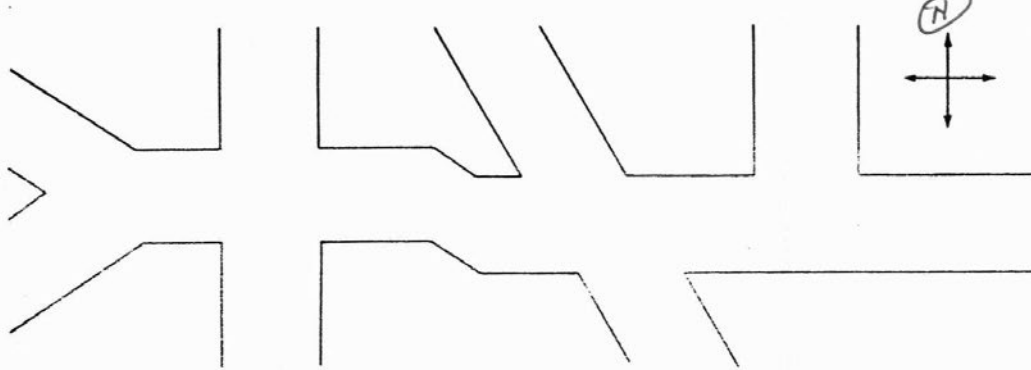
